○Cherry Blossom Trees in Ayaori



The 1.2km long row of cherry trees in Ayaori, with approximately 100 Someiyoshino cherry trees, is at its best from mid-April to mid-May. You can simply watch from your car while driving, or you can take a leisurely stroll along the bicycle path to view the rows of cherry trees.

Hop Harvest Festival

Tono is a production area for hops, one of the raw materials for beer. This is an event that celebrates the hop harvest held at the end of August every year. You can enjoy more than 30 types of beer, and there are also many snacks from restaurants in Tono City. Tono Dobekko Festival

Doburoku, or Dobekko as it is called in Tono, is an alcoholic beverage made from rice. The Dobekko Festival is held at the traditional Nambu Magariya house, where you can enjoy folk tales told by storytellers and local performing arts while drinking Doburoku. There is also a shuttle bus from Tono Station, so everyone can drink together. It's held at set times between mid-November and March. (6-5-1 Tsuchibuchi, Tsuchibuchi-cho, Tono-shi, Iwate 028-0555)

Keiran

It's made by wrapping steamed bean paste in a thin skin of rice flour and boiling. Keiran is a traditional warm sweet from Tono.

Akegarasu

Rice flour, sesame, and walnuts are used to make this confectionary. The texture is somewhere between rice cake and rakugan, and the more you bite into it, the richer the flavor of the ingredients becomes. The walnut cutouts look like a flying crow, hence the name "Akegarasu".
